Prof. John Ishiyama, University of North Texas

John Ishiyama is a Distinguished Research Professor of Political Science at University of North Texas. Prof. Ishiyama is currently the president of the American Political Science Association and Piper Professor of Texas. He specializes on Comparative Politics: democratization and political parties in post communist Russian, European, Eurasian and African (especially Ethiopian) politics, ethnic conflict and ethnic politics, and the scholarship of teaching and learning. He was also the editor in chief of the American Political Science Review 2012-2016.



Prof. Marijke Breuning, University of North Texas

Marijke Breuning is a Professor of Political Science at the University of North Texas. She earned her PhD at the Ohio State University. She specializes in foreign policy analysis, with a specific interest in development cooperation and small states, as well as the politics of international children's rights (and especially intercountry adoption), women/gender and politics, and the sociology of the profession. She served as editor of the *American Political Science Review* (2012-2016). Previously, she served as a member of the inaugural editorial team of *Foreign Policy Analysis* (2005-2009), co-editor of the *Journal of Political Science Education* (2005-2012), and book review editor of *International Politics* (2000-2003).
